Anne is a faculty member of the Academy for Jewish Religion, California, where she is Professor of Ritual and Human Development. A frequent contributor to the Los Angeles Jewish Journal, Anne was ordained as a Reform Rabbi in 2008 in Los Angeles. She is also a graduate of Hebrew Union College's School of Communal Service (1983), and the University of Southern California's School of Social Work (1983), as well as San Francisco State's Department of Broadcast Communication Arts (1976).

Anne is a founding faculty member of Yedidya's Morei Derekh- Jewish Spiritual Direction Program and serves on the Steering Committee of Hebrew Union College's: Kalsman Institute on Medicine and Judaism.
